IT'S AN INSIDE JOB

I recall a time while strolling along the paths of the Japanese gardens and islands at the Chicago Botanic Gardens that I came to the zig zag bridge. Well, the ancient tradition of this bridge having right angle turns in it is that evil spirits can only travel in a straight line and fall into the water when they can't make the zig, much less the zag. And I suddenly thought (light bulb moment!) that maybe life has its zigs and zags for the same reason. The ego's course is determined by linear thinking—one-dimensional, lacking options, and only the unexpected twists and turns in life can loosen its grip.

Picture downhill skiing. I've never skied, but I've watched the winter Olympic Games on TV. What would happen if skiers went straight downhill? They'd pick up so much speed they wouldn't be able to stop, and they'd crash at the bottom of the slope. But they don't ski straight down. They make turns around marker poles which cause them to angle back and forth down the course.

This tells us that the unexpected twists and misadventures in life may scare us or trip us up, but they make us pause, exhale and take notice. They cause us to become flexible—supple—to help us bend in the wind. The obstacles in our lives are the marker poles, and when we look back we can see how that led to our next opportunity. But if we move along too fast with all the confidence of ego, our lives become unmanageable, and we crash and burn. Also, we miss the sacredness of life, the experience of Divine Love moving through us and everyone and everything around us.

At the end of Victor Hugo's *Les Misérables*, the police officer Javert, having shown mercy to Jean Valjean, cannot reconcile that action with his absolute belief in law and retribution and kills himself. His rigidity of mind can't follow Valjean over the zig zag bridge of growth and change, and he plunges into the water.

God, help me to appreciate the back and forth angles and even the ups and downs of life for the purpose of extending Your love in the world through me. Amen.
