We also want to thank Gail O'Neil for her service on the Board for the last two years. And thanks to all who attended the Annual Congregational Meeting. If you missed it, you can find notes and the Power Point presentation on the bulletin board in Fellowship Hall. It was a great meeting!!!

The Board has reviewed with Brenda Smith and Paul Humpfer the building's maintenance and projects along with timeframes. The carpeting outside the main entrance door has been replaced, and the tile in the hallway by the door is to be replaced. We are awaiting the drainage project to be completed with Brenda following up with the contractor.
